
## PARAMOUNT® STARTER

## **Directions For Application**

Prepare the deck as directed on the PARAMOUNT® shingle package.

The First Starter Course is started with PABCO® Universal Starter. Remove 7-1/2" from the end. Place the piece at the lower corner of the deck with the sealant stripe up, overhanging the drip edge 3/8" at the rake and eave.

PABCO® recommends the use of nails. Attach with 4 nails at least 1" long, placed just above the sealant stripe. Finish across the deck with full length pieces.




The Second Starter Course is started with a piece of PARAMOUNT® STARTER matching the color of PARAMOUNT for the rest of the roof. Remove 5-3/4" from the end. Place the piece at the lower corner of the deck. Align the piece with the First Starter Course.

Attach with 4 nails at least 1" long, placed in the nail area. For application in high wind areas, use 6 nails. The nail area is the area above the shadow line (darker band of granules) and below the sealant stripe.

## NAILS MUST BE ABOVE THE SHADOW LINE.

Finish across the deck with full length pieces.






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The First PARAMOUNT® Course is started with a full PARAMOUNT Shingle. Place the shingle at the lower corner of the deck. Align the end and the bottom of the shingle teeth with the Second Starter Course.

Attach with 5 nails, placed in the nail zone. The nail zone is a band of light colored granules running across the face of the shingles 9-1/2" to 11" up from the leading edge of the teeth. Follow the instructions for diagonal application found on the shingle bundle.
